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INTRODUCTION

The book “Mastering English Vocabulary in Real Estate” introduces the first-year students of Vilnius Gediminas Technical University to the profession of real estate management and appraising, and the language of science.

It goes without saying, that in addition to special training any profession also requires professional vocabulary – specific words related to that profession. Thus, this book helps students studying real estate appraising both develop their language skills and get familiar with new English words and their Lithuanian equivalents.

Each of the eighteen units of this educational book consists of several parts. The first part of each unit contains the word list, reading activity and vocabulary section. The word list at the beginning of each unit introduces new vocabulary and terms related to the profession of real estate appraising. Reading activities present short informative texts related to the students’ future profession. Each text is followed by the variety of activities that help students develop their speaking and writing skills and consolidate the main subject material.

The second part of each unit presents focus on grammar with the revision of the basic usage of tense forms, features of parts of speech as well as of syntactic structures. The variety of grammar exercises help to prepare specialists who speak grammatically correct English.

The final, third, section of each unit – Language focus – explains the usage of the most “deceitful” lexical and grammatical items. These explanations are followed by the exercises that help consolidate the usage of the items explained.

Supplementary texts should provide students with the insight into the culture of the English speaking countries. These cultural notes are designed for independent work.

The glossary of terms related to real estate is presented at the end of the book.
